Sacred Heart Roof / OLHC Spire Update

After discussing our proposal to replace the roof with the diocese, it has been decided to gather additional information regarding the roof assembly. This investigation will be conducted by the firm of Allan Avis Architects. The information will allow the committee to make an informed decision with respect to the appropriate material and method to replace the current roof with a view of promoting longevity in whatever material is used. A site visit has been scheduled for September 1st and shortly after a meeting will be held to present and discuss the options.

OLHC Spire/Tower

A site visit has been scheduled for September 1st by the firm of Pow Peterman Consulting Engineers, to review the condition of the spire framing and roofing, the tower masonry and the nave floor framing assembly. The information gathered by the consultants will provide the cluster with the recommendations to properly address these areas in light of the anticipated restoration.
